| <p>How greenhouse gases (GHGs) cause climate change.</p> | <p>GHGs are emitted during oil extraction.</p> | <p>GHGs are emitted when oil is transported by truck, rail or ship.</p> | <p>When pipelines, trucks, trains or ships carrying oil get damaged, the oil that is spilled can hurt wildlife and destroys habitat.</p> |
| <p>GHGs are emitted when oil is turned into plastic.</p> | <p>GHGs are emitted when plastic bags are transported to stores by ships, trucks, or trains.</p> | <p>Most plastic bags are used for only 12 minutes before they are thrown away.</p> | <p>Does your municipality recycle plastic bags? YES or NO If YES: Do plastic bags go in the recycling bin or to a depot? If NO: Make sure people know they do not go in the recycling bin.</p> |
| <p>Greenhouse gas emissions and tiny toxic particles that are released when plastic exposed to sunlight breaks down in landfill.</p> | <p>Some plastic bags get trapped between other plastic items in landfill and can't break down. Landfill sites take up more and more space.</p> | <p>Greenhouse gas emissions when plastic is incinerated/burned.</p> | <p>Damage caused when plastic bags end up in animal habitats.</p> |
